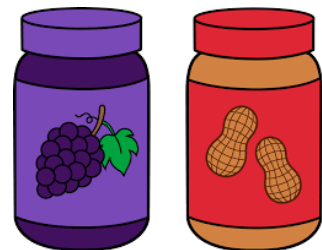

Our songs have been selected with care and love and are intended to reinforce our worship themes while always placing worship and love of God first.

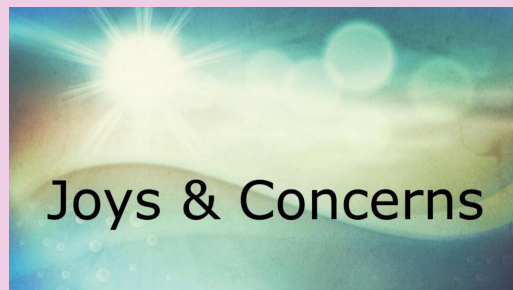
We try to choose songs that are both singable and meaningful. Our selections are supported by the Gospel and by our shared Wesleyan heritage.
